ICDF Prayer Circle

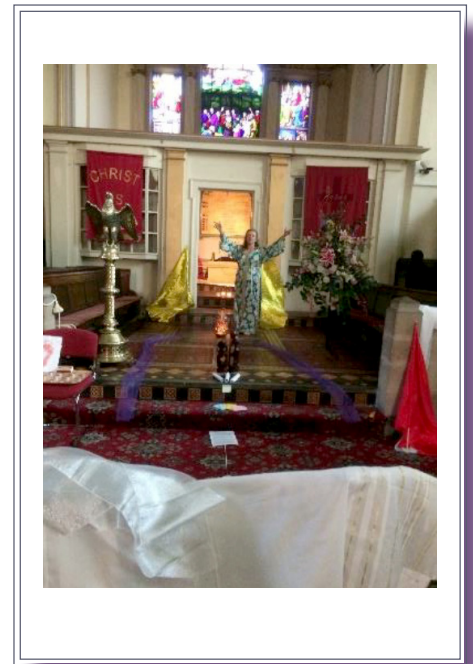
What a Mighty God we serve!
