They came bringing their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. Their journey took them to a far land, following a star for direction, for a purpose. What was that purpose? to worship the Christ Child: "... the star that they had seen in the east went ahead of them until it stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. On coming to the house they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshipped him. For others, that opportunity may not present in public worship but this will be a gift in our heart that can be offered in our personal worship. Before these gifts, though, let us not forget to give the one gift that God truly wants for us to bring to Him in worship this Christmas ... that is the gift of ourselves.

May God bless you as you celebrate the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus, the Christ, the Messiah, this Christmas.

Celebrating CDFA and ICDF

The main focus of the ICDF Foundation in 2018 was on how we would celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Christian Dance Fellowship of Australia and the 30th anniversary of ICDF. On the exact formation date, August 17 which happened to be a Friday this year, people gathered at Mary Jones' house for an informal dinner and conversation.

- The program on Saturday afternoon included circle dance, a time of worship, memories from CDFA Coordinators and performances. The evening program, which also celebrated the 30th anniversary of ICDF, was a dinner followed by the Annual Awards and fundraising activities.
- On the Sunday a number of the participants travelled to western Sydney to take part in a church service and an afternoon experience of 'The New Thing' which is facilitated by Lucy Jarasius and Sharon Ereaux.



Annual Awards

The Peter Jones Youth
Leadership Award (in memory of Mary Jones' late husband), was given for the first time and there were two other Flame Awards ... for one CDFA and one ICDF person who had been involved from the beginning years of the organisations and had continued to serve up to the present. Jennifer Dennis was the recipient of the Award for her service to dance in Australia and Liesl Townsend for her service to dance in CDF South Africa.

Steven Turner, who received the Youth Leadership Award which includes finance to help the recipient attend the next ICDF gathering, advised he was not able to attend the 2019 meeting in India and requested that the money be used to help Indian youth attend.



Theatre Party

The Board again organised a theatre party in July to attend a program by Australia's major indigenous dance company - Bangarra Dance Theatre. This is always enjoyed by those who go and has become an annual event.

Not For Profit

The ICDF Foundation is now recognised by the Australian government as a not-for-profit organisation.

AGM

Our first AGM according to the constitution was held on November 7. After 8 years as Chair I feel it is the right time to hand over the leadership. Consequently, I stepped down as Chair but at the Board's suggestion will stay on as Deputy Chair. I expressed my thanks, with gratitude and appreciation, to those who have served on the Board. Jenny Dennis was appointed as Chair.
