

As in 2020 we had to cope with the reality of Covid-19 but, in retrospect, this opened up new possibilities for working and connecting, for us and for the ICDF countries.

ICDF is a huge operation with many different parts all coming together to make up the whole. So we have the Steering Committee, the Countries, the Networks, the Prayer Circle, the Foundation and the Diploma.

For this year we have been active on a few fronts that we want to mention briefly:

- First of all there is the daily correspondence of replying to emails
- We had four Steering Committee meetings during the course of the year
- Much of our focus was on the updating of the ICDF documents
- There were the monthly publications of the Network newsletters and the Newsflashes
- The website was monitored regularly for updates
- Meetings were held with the Sweden Conference Committee
- The Social Media team went all out to build on our online presence
- The ICDF Networks became more visible
- The new ICDF Online Shop was launched

# **Update of Documents**

- 1) The ICDF constitution has been taken apart and examined from all angles and was voted on by the ICDF Wider Committee at the recent AGM
- 2) The Memorandum of Understanding and the Letter of Agreement for countries have been brought in line with the new proposed constitution
- 3) The guidelines for Network Leaders have been updated looking at current practises and ways of connecting by making use of available technology
- 4) We are still in the process of updating the ICDF Manual one chapter at a time

# Country

## **ICDF** Ireland

At the start of the year we planned to hold monthly dance workshops via Zoom. These were facilitated by the lovely Hannah Mettler from the Ad Deum Dance Company. Three sessions were held in total: January, February and April. We thoroughly enjoyed these workshops.

In March 2021 to celebrate the 30th Anniversary of Christian Dance Fellowship of Ireland's formation in 1991, we held an online Zoom dance conference which was facilitated by Randall Flinn, Choreographer & Founder of Ad Deum Dance Company, Texas, America. This was a wonderful conference and we were all really

encouraged and blessed in the Lord by it. On the first night during the celebration Rosa Burton, our worship leader at the time, taught us a beautiful movement whilst using a scarf to the awesome & anointed song, "You're Still God" by Philippa Hanna. The other sessions over the weekend included some short videos of past events and the dance teaching was facilitated by Randall Flinn. The Friday evening celebration included a slide show presentation of past National Coordinators and a selection of photos from past events throughout the years.

## **ICDF** Australia

The New Thing (TNT): activate the arts to create and heal is the transitional expression of ICDF Country ministry here in these lands now known as Australia. Our monthly gatherings during 2021 have been facilitated via Zoom, except for one, in June, which was a hybrid of real-space and cyberspace, broadcast from the home of the guest presenter, Yumi Schaefer, a Dance Movement Therapist. Since Covid Lockdown restrictions beginning in March the previous year of 2020, we had been "on the fly" as we call it... learning as we went how to engage people physically present complying with social distancing and numbers per square metre requirements ALONG WITH people tuning in from remote locations. We even broadcast one session from the cabin of a car due to a venue hire booking mix-up and pouring rain weather conditions making it impossible to utilise the great outdoors and having to send people home to tune in via Zoom! Talk about tenacity and ingenuity... creatives are 'can-do' people, right?!





## **ICDF Puerto Rico**

In October Puerto Rico saw a new flame ignited as they sought the Lord's face for the reactivation of ICDF Puerto Rico with the theme "Together exalting our King!!!" Their quest is to have representatives from each town in Puerto Rico by the end of 2022

## **ICDF Scandinavia**

The highlight of this year was the Annual Dance Conference, October 22nd – 24th, where approximately 37 ICDF members and other dancers from the different Scandinavian countries were able to meet again in Sweden and dance together after 2 years of being apart. We met at the most beautiful location at the Swedish west coast. "Oh, how wonderful it is to dance before the Lord" was the theme for this annual conference.



Indeed it was. There was a special atmosphere of the Lord's presence. Both teachers, Annasara Yderstad Karlsson and Katarina Stella carry the essence of us being children before God, so there was a unique sense of freedom where the participants met with God and blessed each other in many ways. Some received new levels of freedom in different areas of their lives as we prayed for each other with movement and different materials. We added words to each other after the prayers.

It was awesome to end a wonderful day of workshops outside, as the group altogether praised God with a beautiful banner choreography based on Psalms 150. We are excited that God led new and younger people to join us in Psalto. It renews our hope for what God has in store for Scandinavia in the future. Annasara Yderstad Karlsson has also produced a video named "Heal Our Land" in cooperation with dancers from the Nordic countries and abroad. This past year has been very different for members of Psalto dansewise due to different levels of Covid 19 restrictions in the different countries. Some have not been able to dance together with others until recently; some had the possibility to dance, if they wore masks. Some have had the possibility to worship God dancing outside in sunshine or even hail. Workshops online have been a huge blessing as we have had the possibility to join different online workshops either facilitated in Scandinavia or through our wider ICDF Network. The Danes enjoyed having Steven Turner from CDF Britain teach us twice online as we met physically as a dance group in Denmark.

Much is possible due to online platforms. That inspires us in the preparation of the ICDF International Conference in August 2022 as it makes the conference more accessible worldwide despite the Covid 19 restrictions there might be next year. We're so honoured to be your hosts, and we're excited to see this conference happening. We are thrilled that as many as possible can join us in experiencing how God unfolds the theme "I came to give life with joy and abundance" for us all. With Eph. 2,10 our prayer for ICDF worldwide is that we'll know the love of God deeper and have the wisdom to see what good deeds He's planned for us to walk in.

## ICDF Aotearoa New Zealand

In 2020 Belinda Andrews presented a vision for a Christian Dance Tour of both the South and North Islands of New Zealand (rather than holding a conference) and shared an image she had of a bus with ICDFANZ printed on the side touring the nation. Essentially this was to follow-up on seeds already planted by Rhoze Rivera's

After discussing this and seeking the Lord, the National Committee agreed that these proposed tours were a good idea but due to COVID-19 situation both tours were planned for 2021. The South Island tour took place from 1-15 May 2021 but due to Covid the North Island tour has been postponed to April 2022.
