### **Morning Streams and Workshop Leaders**

Mainstream Workshops (choose one 2 hour workshop from the list below to be followed for 3 days)

#### 1. Storytelling with Dance, Drama and Music

Classical Indian Dance Technique incorporating drama and music to tell a story with a typically Indian flavour. Workshop Leader: Samson Manwatkar

#### 2. Tak Tong-Tong Dance

Tak Tong-Tong Dance follows the rhythm of the dynamic folk song Tak Tong-Tong from West Sumatra, Indonesia and displays richly colourful costumes. Dancers will use tambourines while dancing Tak Tong-Tong and will be required to bring their own tambourines with them. Workshop Leader: Lina Lasup

#### 3. Western Dance Technique

This workshop is a movement technique class that combines ideas from Modern, Jazz and even Hip Hop to create a contemporary, relevant dance style that will challenge you and get you moving in multiple ways. #### 4. SHOUT - Social Concern: Speaking for the voiceless

Learn more about how we can model and mediate the dynamic reality of the church Jesus is building. We are purposed to prevail, to proclaim the good news, to set the oppressed free, and to herald the year of the Lord's favour!
